DELAWARE YARD WASTE BAN NOTICE!

Yard Waste CAN NOT be commingled with your residential household trash.

What is yard waste?

Yard Waste is defined as plant material resulting from lawn maintenance such as grass clippings, leaves pruning, brush, shrubs, garden material and branches.

Why is there a ban on yard waste?

By diverting yard waste from the landfill, the life expectancy of the landfill will be extended.

What happens if I mix my yard waste with my regular trash?

Your trash will not be picked up and fines may be imposed.

What should I do with my yard waste?

THERE ARE SEVERAL OPTIONS:

- OPTION ONE: Sign up with us by Joining our Yard Waste Program!

\$8 Per Month, Billed Quarterly (\$24)
Weekly Pick-Up From May through October, Every Monday.
Twice A Month Pick-Up From November through April,
1st and 3rd Mondays.
- OPTION TWO: Take your Yard Waste to One of the FREE Three Drop-Off
Facilities:
1) Dart's Mid County Facility, Route 13 and 72, near Bear.
2) Poly Drummond Mill Road, Across from the Entrance to Judge Morris Estate.
3) Intersection of Cauffiel Parkway and Philadelphia Pike.
- OPTION THREE: Start a compost pile in your own yard.
